



## Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections “I Voted” and “Future Voter” Sticker Design Contest

The Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections office is challenging Palm Beach County Middle School and High School students\* to design new “I Voted” and “Future Voter” stickers for Palm Beach County voters. We appreciate your help engaging students\* in the democratic process and thank you for encouraging creativity, activities to build character, and civic engagement.

### The Contest

The contest is open to Palm Beach County Middle School and High School students\*. Multiple entries are permitted. Students\* may submit a design for either or both “I Voted” and “Future Voter” stickers. A first-place winner and a runner-up will be chosen for each “I Voted” and “Future Voter” sticker design.

### Prize Winners

The two first-place winners will each receive a two-hundred- and fifty-dollar (\$250.00) cash prize and lunch\*\* by McDonald’s owned and operated by “B”ing the Best, Inc. for the class (or class period) of their choice. Two runner-up winners will receive a one-hundred-dollar (\$100.00) cash prize. All winners will receive a student membership to the Norton Museum of Art for one year and be featured on social media networks and printed marketing.

## How to Enter

Participants must agree to the official contest rules and submit their design(s) by completing and submitting the required pages of this packet (pages 3-4). The deadline to submit all entries is by 5:00 p.m. on **Friday, April 1, 2022**.

All student contest entrants must reside within Palm Beach County.

- All artwork submitted must be the student's original artwork and may not include any copyright images.
- Artwork must include the phrase "I Voted" or "Future Voter."
- Artwork must be nonpartisan and may not promote any party, candidate, or issue.
- Artwork may, but is not required to, portray images regarding Palm Beach County.
- Entries may be submitted using the attached template or using your own materials. Don't forget to include your name! Keep in mind that the design will be printed on a 2" x 2" sticker.

Your artwork must be two-dimensional, and round. By submitting an entry, you acknowledge that your entry: a) is your original work; b) does not contain references to any candidates or political parties or advocate for or against any issue; is nonpartisan; c) does not contain material or images that are, in the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections office (Elections Office) sole judgment, obscene, inappropriate for a general audience that may include minors, or defamatory; d) does not violate or infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other rights of any person or entity; e) does not and will not violate any applicable law, statute, ordinance, rule or regulation; f) does not feature the likeness of a private individual without that individual's written permission for its use; and g) does not trigger any reporting or royalty obligation to any third party. Further, all entries shall be deemed, and shall remain, the property of the Elections Office. The Elections Office shall not be subject to any obligation(s) of confidentiality with respect to any entries, nor is the Elections Office liable for any use or disclosure of any entries. Without limitations of the foregoing, the undersigned hereby grants the Elections Office a worldwide, perpetual, non-exclusive license of every kind and nature, and the Elections Office shall be entitled to unrestricted use of the entries for any purpose whatsoever, commercial, or otherwise, without compensation to the provider of the entries or any other person or entity.

By entering the contest, each contestant agrees to a) comply with and be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Supervisor of Elections Office, which are binding and final in all matters relating to this contest; b) release and hold harmless the Supervisor of Elections, and its officers and employees, and any other organizations sponsoring, advertising or promoting the contest, and all of their respective officers, directors, and employees.

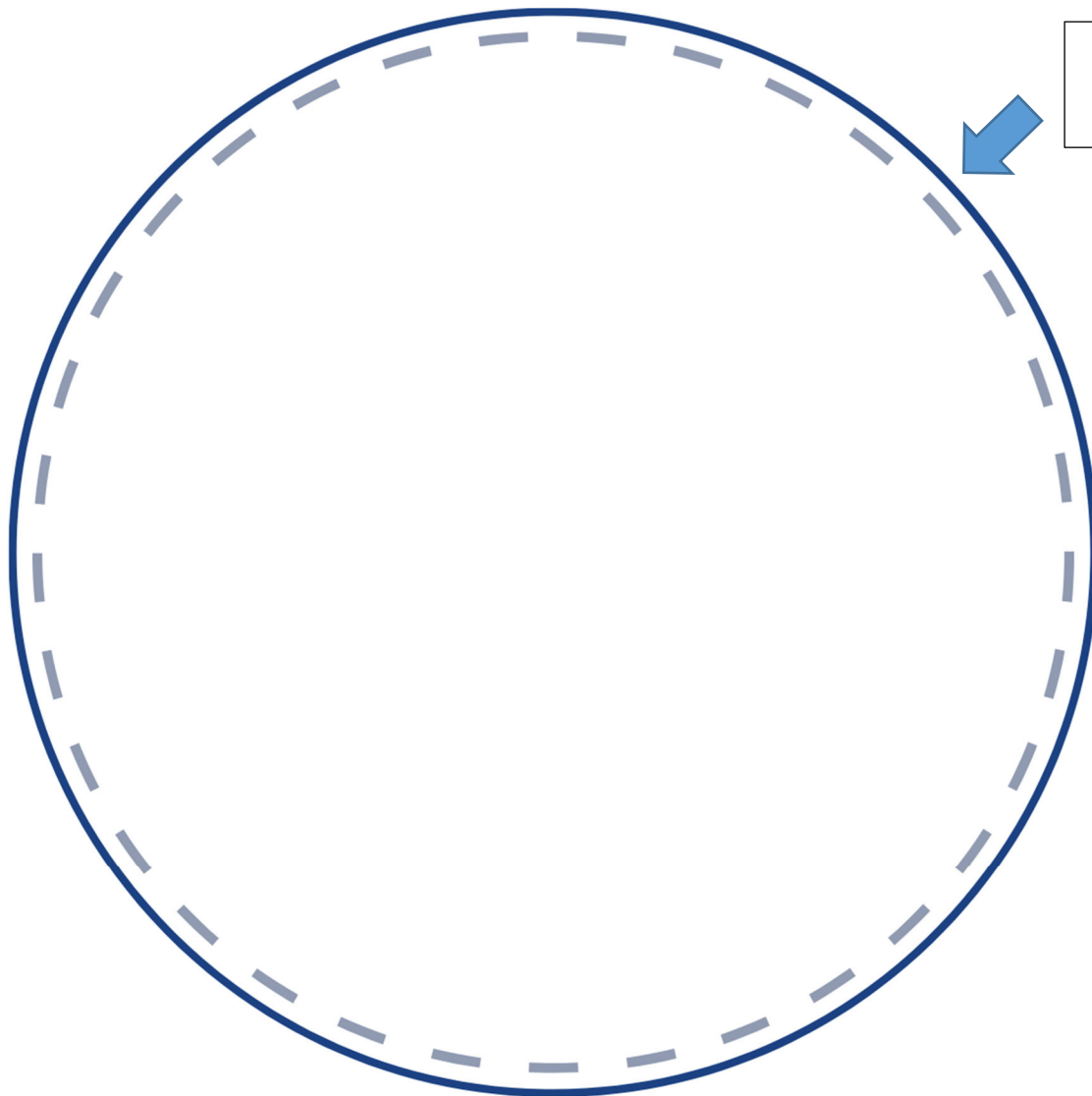


## Sticker Design Contest Template

Remember: the winning artwork must be clear and impactful when reduced to a 2" x 2" size for sticker printing. Keep important aspects of your design such as text well inside the dotted area within the circle.
