**Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections Office to serve the public remotely;  
all functions remain active remotely or by appointment**

Palm Beach County, FL – Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections Wendy Sartory Link announces that the SOE offices will serve the public remotely beginning Monday, March 23, 2020 until further notice. While the four physical offices will limit access to the general public in response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, all services will be available to our residents by phone, email, through our website, and by appointment.

“We are committed to the health and safety of our staff and the members of our community. Though our office’s physical space will limit access to the public, I remain committed to serving voters, candidates, poll workers, and other members of the public through our website, email, and by phone. When necessary to conduct elections related business, we will meet with members of the public by appointment,” said Wendy Link, Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections.

The next meeting of the canvassing board to canvass military and overseas ballots and to certify the official election results is scheduled for March 27, 2020 at 4:00p.m.
